

**May 12, 2015**

A Work-Study Meeting of the Chapman City Council was held May 12, 2015 at the Chapman City Office. Mayor Phil Weishaar called the meeting to order at 6:00 pm. Council members present were Luan Sparks, Jeff Blixt, Tim Jury, Jim Murrison, and newly elected member Lee Wolf. Also in attendance were City Administrator Austin St.John, City Attorney John Purvis, and Assistant City Clerk Rich Hite. Others in attendance were Bobby Kamm, Ryan Hall, Linda Jark-Stoffer, City Engineer Thaniel Monaco with MBG , Marsha Fleming with Kansas Department of Health and Environment, and Jim Lamfers with KRWA.

Austin started the meeting explaining the purpose of the meeting was to discuss what needs to happen with the waste water treatment plant. The City has a 5 year permit and limits will apply after the permit expires. The options discussed were upgrading the present plant by adding on, build a new plant, or build lagoons. The lift station and its potential to become a major problem was also discussed.

The last few minutes of the meeting were spent discussing a possible CBDG grant that would be used toward sidewalk improvements in residential areas.
