

ORDINANCE NO.987

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING A SPECIAL EVENT PERMIT AT WHICH ALCOHOL IS SERVED AND CONSUMED; THE CLOSURE OF SHEERAN PARK AND ESTABLISHING SPECIAL RULES AND CONDITIONS FOR SAID EVENT IN CONJUNCTION WITH BIKE ACROSS KANSAS, PURSUANT TO K.S.A. 41-2645.

WHEREAS, THE BIKE ACROSS KANSAS is a major event providing economic, recreational, and tourism benefits to Chapman, the city does hereby enact this ordinance to provide a special event on public property in conjunction therewith.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Governing body of the City of Chapman, Kansas:

Section 1:

The City of Chapman, Kansas, does hereby approve and permit the use of public property, specifically Sheeran City Park, for a special event at which alcoholic beverages will be served and consumed

Section 2:

Sheeran City Park, 500 Block of Marshall Street, Chapman, Kansas, shall be closed to normal public use commencing at 3:00 PM and ending at 11:00 PM on June 14, 2017.

Section 3:

Appropriate physical control of access to the park shall be established by the City of Chapman.


Section 4:

Appropriate safety and security measures shall be provided by, or at the direction of, the Chief of the Chapman Police Department.

Section 5: Consumption of alcohol in parked vehicles on city streets shall be prohibited.

Section 6: This Ordinance shall take effect after its approval and passage by the governing body and publication in the official city newspaper.
