

ORDINANCE NO. 984

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER XV, SUBSECTION 428, OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF CHAPMAN REGARDING THE OPERATION OF MUNICIPAL SEWER UTILITIES.

WHEREAS the governing body of the City of Chapman shall approve the necessary ordinances and approve rules and regulations pertaining to the effective management and operation of all city utilities.

WHEREAS it is the responsibility of the governing body to maintain a fee structure for sewer services which generates sufficient funding to maintain the sewer system in a safe and efficient condition.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF CHAPMAN, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. That the Code of the City of Chapman is hereby amended in Chapter 15, subsection 428, to read as follows:

15-428. Sewer service charge.

1. A monthly service charge for the use of services rendered by the sewage disposal system shall be paid to the city by all persons, firms, corporations, and any organization, within or without the city, having a sewer connection, directly or indirectly, with the city shall be as follows:

- a) The minimum monthly bill shall be \$20.00
- b) Every one thousand (1,000) gallons \$3.00

2. All users of the Chapman wastewater collection and treatment system are assessed a monthly user fee to be established and averaged annually.

3. The minimum monthly charge is \$20.00.

4. A fee for each one thousand (1,000) gallons of metered water averaged for the months of January, February, and March shall be charged as set forth above.

5. The average shall be computed in April for each sewage utility customer to become effective with the May sewage billing.


SECTION 2. The fees and billing structure established by this ordinance shall be retroactive back to and beginning, January 1, 2017.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force as of the date of its passage, approval and publication in the official City newspaper as provided by law.

SECTION 4. All prior versions of Subsection 15-428 of the Code of the City of Chapman are hereby repealed in their entirety.


