

ORDINANCE NO.1006

AN ORDINANCE ALLOWING THE MUNICIPAL COURT TO USE A COMMERCIAL DEBT COLLECTION COMPANY IN COLLECTION OF OUTSTANDING AND DELINQUENT DEBTS AND RESTITUTION ORDERS.

It Is Hereby Ordained By The Governing Body Of The City Of Chapman, Kansas, That The Following New Subsection Shall Be Added To Chapter Nine Of The Chapman Municipal Code And Which Shall Read:

Section 1. New Subsection 9-112.


9-112. Use Of Commercial Debt Collection Company Authorized.

A. Pursuant to the guidelines provided in K.S.A. 12-4119, the Municipal Court Judge may order debts owed the municipal court, to include orders of restitution, be sent to a company contracted with the City for collection of debts.

B. The Court may make such orders after finding that all time given by the Court for payment has elapsed and that reasonable measures to collect the debt or restitution order through other court procedures have been unsuccessful.

Section 2. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force after its passage and publication in the official city newspaper.
