

ORDINANCE NO. 1008

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE CHAPMAN PARKS AND RECREATION ADVISORY BOARD, TERMS AND DUTIES.

BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF CHAPMAN, KANSAS, That The Following Chapter 12, Article 2, Subsections 4 Through 6 Shall Be Revised within The Municipal Code Of The City Of Chapman And Shall Read As:

REVISED SECTIONS 1.

12-204. Advisory Board established.

A Parks and Recreation Advisory Board is hereby established consisting of seven members, to serve without pay, for the purpose of advising the City Administrator and governing body on issues related to development and operations of recreational programs and park facilities.

12-205. Board. Appointment and Terms.

The Parks and Recreation Board shall consist of seven (7) members. The Mayor shall initially appoint 3 members for 2 year terms and appoint 4 members for 1 year terms. At the conclusion of the initial terms all members shall serve for 2 year staggered terms.

Up to 2 members of the Parks and Recreation Board may be persons residing outside the Chapman City Limits, but within three (3) miles of the Chapman City Limits.

12-206. Powers and Duties.


In addition to the duties listed in City Ordinance Subsection 1-910, the Parks and Recreation Board shall have the duty to consider any major facility purchase or construction projects and to pass on their non-binding recommendation thereon. Major program additions or deletions to the recreation programs offered shall be submitted to the Parks and Recreation Commission for their non-binding recommendation. Said recommendations made by the commission shall be transmitted to the City Administrator who shall incorporate them into any presentation or recommendations he or she makes with regard to the subject for the governing body. The Parks and Recreation Board may be assigned additional duties by the City Administrator as needed.

SECTION 2. Any prior versions of these subsections are hereby revised and replaced with the language in Section 1.

Section 3. This ordinance shall become effective upon passage by a majority of the governing body and publication in the city newspaper.


