

ORDINANCE NO. 1016

AN ORDINANCE REVISING CHAPMAN CITY ORDINANCE 15-304 WHICH CLARIFIES THE FINANCIAL RESPONSIBILITY FOR UPGRADED ELECTRIC SERVICE AND EQUIPMENT AT AN EXISTING LOCATION.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF CHAPMAN, KANSAS:**

**SECTION 1.** That the Code of the City of Chapman is hereby amended by replacing Chapter 15, Subsection 304, in its entirety, with the following language which reads as follows:

**15-304. Cost of installation borne by consumer.**


- a. The cost of original installation of all wiring services and devices, except feed lines and all extensions hereafter made to such services, as well as all repairs to the same, shall be borne entirely by the consumer, although such services and devices shall at all reasonable time be subject to inspection by duly authorized officials of the city of Chapman. Any repairs found to be necessary such officials shall be made promptly by the consumer or the city will discontinue service unless such repairs are made.
- b. The cost for any upgraded or additional service, equipment, lines, or meters at an existing service location shall be paid by the consumer.

**SECTION 2.** This ordinance shall take effect and be in force as of the date of its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.

**SECTION 3.** All prior versions of Chapter 15, Subsection 304, of the Code of the City of Chapman are hereby repealed in their entirety.
