

June 18, 2018

A work session of the Chapman City Council was held Monday, June 18, 2018 at the Chapman City Office at 5:30pm. Council members present were Mayor Jeff Blixt, Howard Battishill, Lee Wolf, Tim Jury, and Clint Thornton. Council member Luan Sparks was absent. Also in attendance were City Administrator John Dudte and City Clerk Erin Tilton.

The purpose of the work study was to review the first draft of the 2019 budget. City Administrator Dudte pointed out that the appraised value of Chapman had decreased 1%, therefor the mil levy value decreased slightly as well. After some discussion the council directed city staff to amend the proposed budget to show the following:

- 1 mil increase to recover only the funds that were lost from the decrease in appraised value
- \$0.05/kwh increase in electric rates to help fund additional department needs in fire and police
- \$5 sewer surcharge to begin saving funds for the sewer lagoon project

A work session will be set up at the July council meeting for a final review of the proposed budget.
