

ORDINANCE NO. 104

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING A SPECIAL EVENT PERMIT AT WHICH ALCOHOL IS SERVED AND CONSUMED; THE CLOSURE OF SHEERAN PARK SHELTER HOUSE AND ESTABLISHING SPECIAL RULES AND CONDITIONS FOR SAID EVENT IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE ALS FUNDRAISER, PURSUANT TO K.S.A. 41-2645.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Governing body of the City of Chapman, Kansas:

Section 1:

The City of Chapman, Kansas, does hereby approve and permit the use of public property, specifically the Sheeran City Park Shelter House, for a special event at which alcoholic beverages will be served and consumed under a One-Day Temporary Permit issued by the Kansas Department of Revenue to ALS Awareness/ Fundraiser GMARSHALLSTRONG and permit applicant Tina Holliman.

Section 2:

The Sheeran City Park Shelter House, 500 Block of Marshall Street, Chapman, Kansas, shall be closed to normal public use commencing at noon, 12:00 PM and ending at 6:00 PM on October 27, 2018.

Section 3:

Appropriate physical control of access to the park shelter house area shall be established by the permit applicant through fencing or other appropriate physical barriers. A designated person shall control the access points.


Section 4:

Appropriate safety and security measures shall be approved by the Chapman Chief of Police.

Section 5: Consumption of alcohol in parked vehicles on city streets shall be prohibited.

Section 6: This Ordinance shall take effect after its approval and passage by the governing body and publication in the official city newspaper.
