That on the 14th day of November, 2018, the Chapman City Council passed Ordinance Number 1019.

This ordinance amends Chapter VII, subsection 305 (7-305) of the Municipal Code of the City of Chapman, Kansas, regarding the issuance of permits for the commercial sales of fireworks. The ordinance provides an exception for permits issued in 2018 regarding location.

ORDINANCE NO. 1019

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER VII, SUBSECTION 305 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF CHAPMAN REGARDING THE PERMITTING OF FIREWORKS STANDS.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Governing body of the City of Chapman, Kansas:

Chapter 7, Subsection 305 of the Code of the City of Chapman, Kansas, is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 1. AMENDED SECTION:

7-305. Permit for sale of fireworks required; fee; issuance, exception.

(a) It shall be unlawful for any person to sell, display for sell, offer to sell or give away any type of fireworks within the city without first paying a fee of \$200.00 per establishment or premises to the city clerk and applying for and securing a permit therefor on or before June 1st of the permit year.

(b) No permit shall be issued for any location where retail sales are not permitted under the zoning laws. Except that the two fireworks stands which were permitted for 2018 shall be allowed to continue to use the location they were at in 2018, so long as, it is the same permittee at the same location. Upon any transfer of a permittee's business to different owners, operators, or officers, as well as, transfer of the real property, this exception shall then be discontinued and void thereafter. This exception does not inure to the real property.


(c) Prior to the issuance of the permit, an inspection will be made of the applicant's facility for compliance with this chapter and other pertinent laws, and no permit shall be issued for any premises not in compliance with such laws. Upon qualifying for the permit, the permittee shall prominently display the same at the establishment or premises where fireworks are to be sold or displayed for sale. The permit fee shall not be refundable upon failure to qualify for the permit or withdrawal or cancellation of the application or permit.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall become effective upon approval and passage by the governing body and publication as required by law.

SECTION 3. All prior versions of City Code Section 7-305 are hereby repealed.

PASSED AND APPROVED by the Governing Body of the City of Chapman, Kansas, a majority being in favor thereof, this 14th day of November, 2018.


