

ORDINANCE NO. 989

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING A SPECIAL EVENT PERMIT AT WHICH ALCOHOL IS SERVED AND CONSUMED OFFSITE.

WHEREAS, Labor Day is an important holiday in the City of Chapman and the celebration thereof is an important part of our community as well as a part of our economic vitality.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Governing body of the City of Chapman, Kansas:

Section 1:

The City of Chapman, Kansas, does hereby approve a one (1) day special permit allowing Smokey Hill Retail Liquor to operate an off-site beer garden area directly north of their existing business under the following rules:

1. The area will be securely fenced and access controlled through a staffed entrance where identification will be checked.
2. No one will be allowed to enter the beer garden from the liquor store.
3. No alcoholic beverages will be allowed to be removed from the beer garden.

Section 2:

This permit is valid only for the day of September 4, 2017, between the hours of 10:00 AM and 7:00PM.

Section 3:

This permit is contingent upon the acquisition of any permits required by the State of Kansas and the adherence to any additional regulations of the State.

Section 4:


This Ordinance shall take effect after its approval and passage by the governing body and publication in the official city newspaper.
