

ORDINANCE NO.995

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING A SPECIAL EVENT PERMIT AT WHICH ALCOHOL IS SERVED AND CONSUMED OFFSITE AND A CITY STREET IS CLOSED FOR A DANCE.

WHEREAS, Labor Day is an important holiday in the City of Chapman and the celebration thereof is an important part of our community as well as a part of our economic vitality.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Governing body of the City of Chapman, Kansas:

Section 1:

The City of Chapman, Kansas, does hereby approve a one (1) day special permit allowing the Lawrence-Brunswick American Legion Post 240 to extend their liquor license and operate an off-site area directly north of their existing establishment on NE 3rd Street, for a street dance and consumption of alcohol under the following rules:

1. The area will be securely fenced and access allowed only through the American Legion.
2. No alcoholic beverages will be allowed to be removed from the beer garden or Legion property pursuant to State regulations.
3. The American Legion shall staff the event with its own members.
4. The event will only be open to members of the American Legion and their guests.

Section 2:

This permit is valid only for the day of September 2, 2017, beginning at 6:00 PM and ending at 1:00 AM, September 3, 2017, when the fence will be removed and trash picked up. The 100 block of NE 3rd Street directly north of the American Legion shall be closed to traffic during these hours and a dance is authorized thereon.

Section 3:

The City Administrator is authorized to loan up to eight (8) city picnic tables to the American Legion for this event.


Section 4:

This permit is contingent upon the acquisition of any permits required by the State of Kansas and the adherence to any additional regulations of the State.

Section 5:

This Ordinance shall take effect after its approval and passage by the governing body and publication in the official city newspaper.
