

ORDINANCE NO. 1052

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 13, SUBSECTION 206, PROTECTING CURBS FROM DAMAGE BY REQUIRING REGULAR DRIVEWAY ACCESS AT LOCATIONS DESIGNED AND BUILT FOR SUCH PURPOSES AND DESIGNATING ISSUER OF PERMITS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF CHAPMAN, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. Amended Section. The following Chapter 13, Subsection 206, of the Code of the City of Chapman, Kansas, shall be amended to read as follows.


13-206. Cutting curbs; pavement; driving over curbs.

- (a) No person shall cut, damage, break, or alter any curb, gutter, pavement, blacktop, and sidewalk or excavate any street, alley or other public grounds of the city for any purpose without first obtaining a permit authorizing the same from the City Administrator or designee thereof.
- (b) Once the work for which the excavation was made has been completed the city shall restore the pavement, blacktop, sidewalk or other surfacing at the expense of the person from whom the excavation was made.
- (c) In lieu of the city replacing pavement, it may elect to authorize utility companies or contractors to resurface streets or sidewalks with like materials, subject to approval of the City Administrator or designee thereof.
- (d) It shall be unlawful to drive a motor vehicle, required to be tagged, over a curb to facilitate the parking of a motor vehicle or trailer on a regular or repeated basis. Only those locations specifically designed and built through curbing as driveway access shall be used.

SECTION 2. All prior versions of this code subsection shall be void as of the passage and publication of this ordinance.


SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after passage and publication in the official city newspaper.
