

ORDINANCE NO. 1037

AN ORDINANCE CREATING A NEW CHAPTER 14, SUBSECTION 403, WHICH SETS A MAXIMUM SPEED LIMIT OF 20 MILES PER HOUR ON A PARTICULAR SECTION OF EAST 6<sup>TH</sup> STREET FOR THE PROTECTION OF CHILDREN AND PEDESTRIANS.

WHEREAS, it is recommended by the Chapman Police Department and the Chapman Public Works Department that due to the heightened presence of children and other pedestrians along east 6<sup>th</sup> Street, between Marshall Avenue and the Beemer Ball Complex, a reduced speed limit is needed to enhance public safety.

THEREFORE, the governing body does adopt the recommendations of the city staff and finds that a reduced speed limit should be established on east 6<sup>th</sup> Street to enhance safety of children and other pedestrians.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF CHAPMAN, KANSAS:


**SECTION 1. New Section.** Chapter 14, of the Code of the City of Chapman, Kansas, shall be amended with a new Subsection 403, which will read as follows:

- 14-403. Reduced Speed Zone established on East 6<sup>th</sup> Street.
- The speed limit on east 6<sup>th</sup> Street from Marshall Avenue to the south entrance of the Daryl Beemer Ball Complex shall be 20 miles per hour at all times.
  - Fines for violation of the speed limit shall be set pursuant to the regular fine schedule unless a different special zone shall be in effect including, but not limited to, construction zones.

**SECTION 2.** The Public Works Department shall erect speed limit signage pursuant to the current version of the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices as required by state statute.

**SECTION 3.** This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after passage and publication pursuant to statute.
