Upon the discontinuance of any service at the request of any depositor, the deposit shall be refunded with accrued interest upon surrender of the original receipt less any amount due owing the city for services furnished prior thereto or the deposit may be credited toward the payment of the final bill rendered to the customer.

The City of Chapman requires any person establishing city utility service to first pay a deposit on the account. Furthermore, it requires the submission of certain information pertaining to the utility customer. Among these items are the driver's license and social security numbers. This information is used only for collections in situations where the customer leaves without paying their utility bill in full.

The third-party use of social security numbers is not prohibited by state or federal law. As you may already know, it is regularly used in credit applications and banking. It is a normal practice for cities and private utility providers to require social security numbers in setting up utility accounts.

Therefore, city utility service shall not be provided until all requested information is provided.
