

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF CHAPMAN, KANSAS, GRANTING A PERMIT TO ALLOW A PUBLIC FIREWORKS DISPLAY AND WAIVING THE 30 DAY ADVANCE APPLICATION REQUIREMENT AND ANY REQUIRED FEE**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Chapman has a tradition of celebrating the Labor Day holiday each year; and

**WHEREAS**, it is proper for the City to promote community events which provide recreation and are an economic enhancement by drawing in visitors who patronize local business; and

**WHEREAS**, the City has a history of fireworks displays for the Labor Day celebration;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF CHAPMAN, KANSAS:**

**Section 1.** The City of Chapman hereby grants itself a permit to conduct a public fireworks display.

**Section 2.** The City of Chapman hereby waives the requirement to apply at least 30 days before the event.

**Section 3.** The City of Chapman hereby waives any permit fees required for said fireworks display.

**Section 4.** The following information is provided as required for the application pursuant to code section 7-306(1) – (7).

- 1) The name of the applicant. City of Chapman, Kansas
- 2) The group for which the display is planned. City of Chapman, Kansas
- 3) The location of the display. Indian Hill Golf Course, City owned property
- 4) The date and time of the display. Sunday, September 5, 2021 at dusk (about 9:30 PM)
- 5) The nature or kind of fireworks to be used. Aerial ignitions
- 6) The name of the person, firm or corporation that will make the actual discharge of the fireworks. Daryl Ash will be the technician discharging the fireworks.
- 7) Anticipated need for police, fire or other municipal services. The City of Chapman will use local police, other city employees, and volunteers. A portion of the golf course will be used to set up and discharge the fireworks from.

**Section 5.** The City of Chapman has verified with its insurance carrier that it has sufficient insurance to cover this city event. The City of Chapman hereby waives the requirement of purchasing any

separate policy and is allowed to use existing coverage. Additional Product Liability Insurance from the firework supplier Aerial FX will be granted to our fireworks technician, Daryl Ash.

**Section 6.** This resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption.
