

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF CHAPMAN, KANSAS TO LEVY A PROPERTY TAX RATE EXCEEDING THE REVENUE NEUTRAL RATE;**

**WHEREAS**, the Revenue Neutral Rate for the City of Chapman was calculated as 42.323 mills by the Dickinson County Clerk; and

**WHEREAS**, the budget proposed by the Governing Body of the City of Chapman will require the levy of a property tax rate exceeding the Revenue Neutral Rate; and

**WHEREAS**, the Governing Body held a hearing on the 25<sup>th</sup> day of August, 2021, allowing all interested taxpayers desiring to be heard an opportunity to give oral testimony; and

**WHEREAS**, the Governing Body of the City of Chapman, having heard testimony, finds it necessary to exceed the Revenue Neutral Rate.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF CHAPMAN:**

**Section One.** The City of Chapman shall levy a property tax rate exceeding the Revenue Neutral Rate of 42.323 mills.

**Section Two.** This resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption and shall remain in effect until future action is taken by the Governing Body.
