

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF CHAPMAN, KANSAS, TO PAY WALTERS-MORGAN CONSTRUCTION, INC. REQUESTED PROGRESS PAYMENT IN CONSTRUCTION OF THE NEW SANITARY LIFT STATION.

WHEREAS, the City of Chapman has contracted with Walters-Morgan Construction, Inc. for the construction of a new sanitary sewer lift station; and

WHEREAS, said construction contract requires the construction company to submit applications for payment as the project progresses; and

WHEREAS, Walters-Morgan Construction, Inc. has submitted an application for payment on supplies and work accomplished through August 30, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the engineer for the city, Randall Purdue, with Kaw Valley Engineering has recommended the payment of the requested funds; and

WHEREAS, Walters-Morgan Construction, Inc. has submitted an itemized listing of fees for work completed and cost of supplies under Job Number 320-02; and

WHEREAS, the application for payment totals \$7,552.65 for work and supplies through August 30, 2021, and the contract signed by the parties requires the payments be made on a periodic basis as the project progresses.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF CHAPMAN, KANSAS:

Section 1. The City of Chapman shall pay Walters-Morgan Construction, Inc. the sum of \$7,552.65 for supplies and work done through August 30, 2021.

Section 2. This resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption.
