

ORDINANCE NO. 1033

AN ORDINANCE REVISING CHAPTER 2, SUBSECTION 109 OF THE CODE OF CHAPMAN, REGARDING THE KEEPING OF CERTAIN TYPES OF ANIMALS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF CHAPMAN,
KANSAS:

SECTION 1. The following Chapter 2, Subsection 109 of the Code of the City of Chapman, Kansas shall be amended.

AMENDED SECTION 2. That Chapman City Code Section 2-109 shall be amended to read as follows:

2-109. Keeping animals.

It shall be unlawful for the owner, lessee, occupant or person in charge of any premises in the city to:

- (1) Possess and maintain any animal within the city; or
- (2) Permit to be maintained thereon any stable, shed, pen or other place where horses, mules, cattle, sheep, goats or swine, or undomesticated animals are kept.


Provisions (1) and (2) shall not apply to:

- (a) The maintaining of a stockyard or sales barn for the loading, unloading, temporary detention and sale of such livestock, if the location of such stockyard or sales barn does not otherwise violate the zoning or other ordinances of the city;
 - (b) The maintaining of dogs which are regulated by Article 2 of this chapter;
 - (c) The maintaining of non-poisonous and non-vicious animals and birds which are commonly kept as household pets, such as cats, hamsters, guinea pigs, rabbits, parakeets, finches, canaries, parrots, cockatiels, cockatoos and comparable animals, when kept as household pets and in a safe and sanitary manner in accordance with section 2-113 of this chapter;
 - (d) The transporting of animals through the city by ordinary and customary means.
- (3) It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to keep, maintain or have in his or her possession or under his or her control within the city any domesticated birds commonly known as rheas, emus, ostriches, chickens, peafowl, swans, turkeys, ducks, geese, or guinea fowl. Except that they may be transported through the city.

SECTION 3. All ordinances, resolutions or policies or parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby expressly repealed insofar as they conflict herewith.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after passage and publication as provided by law.
