A special council meeting of the Chapman City Council was held Wednesday, August 24, 2022, at City Hall at 6:45pm. Mayor Howard Battishill was present. Councilmembers James Bell, Rick Johnson, Tim Jury, Christy Loy, and Mary Monasmith were present. Also in attendance were City Administrator Bill Flanery and Police Sergeant James Reynolds.

#2 2023 Revenue Neutral Rate Hearing

Mayor Battishill opened the Revenue Neutral Rate (RNR) hearing. No members of the public were present to make public comments. City Administrator Bill Flanery recommended council keep the hearing open to allow for anyone that might arrive late. The proposed revenue neutral rate did not change from the rate established during the RNR/budget workshop on 27 July 2022. The RNR increased due to including the recreation programs in the general fund and properly funding those programs. The rate also increased due to overall inflation. Funding for the recreation program has been a trouble area for several years and the auditor requested it be included in the general fund.

Motion by Jury to close the Revenue Neutral Rate Hearing, 2nd by Bell, vote: yes, unanimous (5-0). Motion carried.
